- Available to Incoming Freshmen Boys:
 - St. Francis Scholarship – *merit based; well-rounded student*
 - St. Felix Scholarship – *merit & service based*
 - Sr. Mary Denise Bernas Scholarship – *service focus; need based (renewable)*
 - Sr. Pulcheria Endowed Scholarship – *need based; STEM focus (renewable)**



Scholarships for OLSH

- Available to Incoming Freshmen Girls:
 - St. Clare Scholarship – *merit based; well-rounded student*
 - Sr. Pulcheria Endowed Scholarship – *need based; STEM focus (renewable)**
 - William J. Wolf Endowed Scholarship – *need & merit based; faith focus (renewable)*



Scholarships for OLSH

- **Available to Upperclassmen:**

- Poleski Family Scholarship – *need & service based; full scholarship for sophomore through senior years at OLSH*
- Collier Family Incentive Scholarship – *need & service based; amounts determined annually*
- Susan Fahey Memorial Scholarship – *merit based; student must be planning to enroll in an upper-level language course senior year*

 - House/vehicle/insurance payment information
 - Be as inclusive of information as possible
- Completed 2016 Tax Returns and W-2 statements ONLY (upload/fax/mail)
- \$30 nonrefundable online application fee

- **Diocese of Pittsburgh**
 - Formerly used PSAS, which has been bought by FACTS
 - Process for application is pending
 - Be prepared to supply proof of registration in a Catholic parish in the Diocese, as has been required in the past
