



## **Sr. M. Pulcheria Saukaitis:** *A Legacy of Innovation and Influence*

Sr. Mary Pulcheria Saukaitis '39 has been a student, alumna, teacher, principal, and friend of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart High School. She holds a special place in the hearts of many of her former students, and her impact in the history and continued success of OLSH cannot be denied.

In 1964, after teaching science for many years, Sr. Pulcheria became the principal of OLSH. Much as she saw the potential in her students and nurtured it, Sr. Pulcheria also saw the potential of OLSH. Faced with the seemingly imminent closure of OLSH, Sr. Pulcheria exhibited commendable foresight and took a risk that would change the school forever. She was instrumental in the decision to make OLSH a co-educational school in the early 1970s.

The decision to admit both male and female students to OLSH was not immediately embraced by all involved, but it was a decision that likely saved the school. Sr. Pulcheria's innovative spirit helped to ensure the continuation of the Felician Sisters' tradition of educational excellence.

Sr. Mary Pulcheria's influence at OLSH did not end with her retirement. She continued to invest in the advancement of OLSH through her donation of handmade blankets to the Legacy Gala. The "Blanketed in Blessings" raffle raised thousands of dollars that directly supported tuition assistance and student programs at OLSH.

Inspired by Sr. Pulcheria's passion and commitment, alumni have come forward in an effort to honor and continue her legacy at OLSH through the creation of the Sister Mary Pulcheria Saukaitis Scholarship. RoGene (Falbo) Clarke '63, who started the scholarship, and many of her fellow alumni envision the scholarship growing to last in perpetuity to honor their teacher and her dedication to OLSH. Donations from alumni and friends were invested in the OLSH endowment to establish a scholarship in Sr. Pulcheria's honor.

The *Sister Mary Pulcheria Saukaitis Scholarship Fund* is an expression of the love and respect of the alumni of OLSH for their former teacher, principal and mentor.

# SR. M. PULCHERIA SAUKAITIS ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship encourages academically talented and motivated young women and young men to focus a portion of their OLSH education on the study of STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics). \*This \$1,000 renewable scholarship will be awarded annually to incoming freshmen students.

*\*Annual award amount is based on OLSH endowment earnings for the prior year*

## ELIGIBILITY/REQUIREMENTS

- Young women and young men
- Application for enrollment submitted to OLSH Admission Office
- Demonstrated financial need based on criteria set forth by OLSH (as determined by FACTS, OLSH's third party tuition and financial aid management system)
- Enthusiasm for learning, especially in the STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics) subject areas

## SCHOLARSHIP RENEWABILITY CRITERIA

- Student must take four years of science, four years of academic mathematics courses and/or coursework in the areas of computer science and engineering while at OLSH (OLSH students are already required to take four years of math)
- Maintain a 3.0 (85%) grade point average in all academic courses, monitored at the end of each semester of study
- Maintain an average conduct score of 90 points or higher

## THE APPLICATION PROCESS

*Applications for the Sr. M. Pulcheria Saukaitis Endowed Scholarship are due to the Admissions Office of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart by March 15.*

*A complete application must include:*

- The application form and completed essay
- 8<sup>th</sup> grade math or science teacher recommendation letter
- List of any academic enrichment program or clubs (after school clubs, honor societies, weekend programs, summer programs) in which you have participated or are currently participating
